Who is eligible?

The criteria for Total Life Healthcare includes:

- Age—you must be 55 years or older.
- Residence—you must live in a Total Life Healthcare service area (see list of ZIP codes).
- The Department of Human Services must certify that you need long-term care services.
- The Total Life Healthcare staff must determine that their support services would allow you to live safely in the community.

What does it cost?

- Total Life Healthcare receives a capitated payment monthly on each participant from Medicare and Medicaid.
- Total Life Healthcare participants may be fully and personally liable for costs if they receive services from an out of provider network or unauthorized service.
